BYE Laws for Connacht Post Primary Schools Camogie

Schools that do not play a match on time, unless they get permission from the committee via email, shall lose the fixture.

Players who move from the B to A panel are also deemed A. Any school entering a 2nd team can do so but only at the next grade down, and cannot represent the Province at All Ireland series with that 2nd team

TEXT Rule: - If an opposing school does not respond to your 2nd Text, then INVOKE TEXT which is as follows: Text or email opponent with suggested dates & cc the Connaught fixtures secretary immediately. (Martina)Secretary will then issue an email or text them. They have 1 day to respond by phone with confirmation of a fixture + time + venue. Walkover will be awarded other wise

Some Finals and semi-finals may be held on weekends (or under lights or in the Dome (if the pitch is unavailable). Get a session in these conditions if you are able.

The gate [Team A] and program [Team B] shall be the responsibility of each side if a committee member is unable to make the game.

When 2 teams finish level on points, the result in their game determines who qualifies.

If 3 or more teams finish level on points, score difference will apply. If any games were conceded, they do not count for any team. Committee decision is final.

Referee and winning school to send the results after the game also. 25 euros per school for referee. Connacht Colleges pay the referees for finals and have a neutral venue.

Schools entering multiple teams for 1st and Minor League must submit separate team panels for each team. Top 20 players play in A, next best in B and so on. Failure to do this results in forfeit. Panel lists are to be sent to the secretary before competition begins or there will be a hold up in competition.

A school's second/third team cannot represent Connacht at the All-Ireland series if they win the Provincial title. Separate panels must be drawn up for second /third teams and sent to the secretary before the competition commences.

All cups to be returned by midterm break to your nearest committee member (Pres Ath, Raphaels Loughrea, Gort, Ard Scoil Ballinasloe).

Official camogie uniform at all games, skorts no shorts. Referees can check before the game.

ALL players must be entered on FOIREANN. Coaches need to be registered also. Contact secretary if there is an issue. Important this done prior to competitions.

First Aid medic to be available at games where possible.

If bringing supporters to finals, 2 euro per student to be gathered beforehand and given in at the gate. Supporters support the players and respect to be always shown.

If your school wishes to regrade, they must do so via email to the Secretary at least 2 weeks before the Agm or a reconvened Agm for discussion at the fixtures meeting. YOU MUST ATTACH proof of results (at least 2 years from now on to keep in line with other provinces). Schools must submit their team lists and clubs along with a list of players they will be losing. They must present a compelling case.

170-euro affiliation fee to be paid within 2 weeks prior to start of competitions. It is each school's responsibility to have this done. Schools must put their name on the narrative and name of contact person. Email treasurer (Caroline Carr) if your school requires a receipt.
