Camogie League Rules 2024/2025

27.05.24



- Senior Competition for players born after 1 July 2005, Junior Competition for players born after 1 July 2008.
- First-named team on fixtures list plays at home. Schools must agree on a neutral venue if traveling distances > 1.5 hrs.
- Away team must contact home team 1x week in advance to confirm time and venue of their next fixture. If the match must be canceled due to weather, the home team must inform the away team no less than 3 hours before the fixture or forfeit the match.
- Ideally fixtures must be fulfilled +/- 5 school days by agreement between the schools; Round games must be played by 04 Oct (Junior), 25 Oct (Senior).
- Matches will be 30-minutes aside on a standard-sized pitch using standard goals, a size 4 sliotar, multiple subs & extra time. Other normal Camogie Association playing rules apply.
- Matches will be 15 a side, but schools can play 12 a side minimum (or as otherwise agreed between schools on the day) to fulfil the fixture. If a team has below 15 players, maximum number of players must be played, without substitutes. If a player gets injured and the opposite team does not have substitutes, both teams must always play the same number of players on the field.
- Semi-finals and finals will be 15-aside (minimum 13)
- 3 points for a win. 2 points for a draw, 1 point for a loss.
- Teams level on points in preliminary rounds will be separated by head-to-head outcome. Teams still level will be separated by aggregate scores conceded in the preliminary rounds. Teams still level will be separated by coin toss.
- Before a match begins, 2x copies of Team Lists on Form CC2 only must be given to the referee. Referee will sign the Team Lists, will give 1x Team List to the opposition and will keep the other for his/her match report which must be retained & submitted to the league co-ordinators via whatsapp/email. The home school must ensure this is done after the game. For insurance purposes, players must wear the jersey numbers allocated on the Team List.
- Immediately after a match, the home team will confirm the score with the referee and will text results to the competition co-ordinator (no. at top of fixtures list) for inclusion in the league table.
- In the event of a drawn final, extra time will be played the same day: 10 minutes a-side. If still drawn, the final will be replayed (with extra time if needed) (more than once if needed) until there is a winner.

- Referee & pitch to be organised by the first named team. Costs split, €25 each for the referee. Caretaker fees to be split if applicable.
- Both teams will provide 2 umpires and 1 linesperson, if possible.
